#### TRANSKRIPCIJE

##### SECTION A

**Int.:** Good morning Brian and welcome to our studio. I don't think all of our listeners know what an au pair is.

**Brian:** Yes, well.....it is a girl or a young woman who comes to live with a family. She wants to learn the language.... but at the same time she has to help them with housework and children.

**I:** Does that mean that only girls can be au pairs?

**B:** Yes, being an au pair is still for girls only.

**I:** I see. Now why do girls want to come to Britain and be au pairs? To earn money and get rich?

**B:** (smile) No, no, no ...Above all they want to improve their English and spend some time here. You know, most families are looking for girls who are willing to stay for at least three months, preferably more. Of course, you get some pocket money. But if you want to be an au pair, keep in mind that life in Britain can be very expensive. The pocket money you will get will not cover all your expenses. For example, ...hmm... bus and underground fares are far from cheap ...and, and London is very big ... you can't just walk around.. Pocket money is just pocket money. So my advice to an au pair is: have money of your own especially if you want to see something of Britain. Language school fees are also costly. And don't forget you should have enough means to pay for the return journey home.

**I:** You said that they want to improve their English language skills. What about someone who doesn't speak English?

**B:** Well, it is important they know at least some English before they come. It is difficult to find a host family if you can't speak a word of English.

**I:** Is there an age limit?

**B:** A girl should be at least 17, but to tell you the truth most families are not very happy to take such young girls. On the other hand, they should not be older than 30.

**I:** What about work?

**B:** A girl who wants to work as an au pair should be prepared to help with light housework and look after children. She takes part in family life and has her own room with heating. She won't have to cook, but she'd better know something about household duties. The British Home Office recommends a daily working time of 5 hours for a 6-day week. In addition there are two or three evenings baby-sitting per week. These of course are not enforceable laws you know. It is more ..... it's more a recommendation.

**I:** That sounds reasonable. But what happens if the girl is not happy with her family. If she is mistreated or something? If she needs help or advice?

**B:** Well she can always contact the Citizen Advice Bureaux where she can get free confidential advice and help on all problems. They have offices all over Britain. She can find the addresses in telephone directories, post offices, libraries, Town Halls, or local Police stations and so on.

**I:** That was very interesting, Brian. Thank you very much.

**B:** Thank you.
